**PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER NOTICE**

DUE TO A WATER MAIN BREAK IN YOUR AREA, WATER WAS TEMPORARILY UNAVAILABLE WHILE THE NECESSARY REPAIRS WERE BEING MADE.

THEREFORE, AS A PRECAUTION, WE ADVISE THAT ALL WATER USED FOR DRINKING, COOKING, MAKING ICE, BRUSHING TEETH, OR WASHING DISHES BE BOILED. A ROLLING BOIL OF ONE MINUTE IS SUFFICIENT. AS AN ALTERNATIVE, BOTTLED WATER MAY BE USED.

THIS "PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER NOTICE" WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL THE PROBLEM HAS BEEN CORRECTED AND A BACTERIOLOGICAL SURVEY SHOWS THAT THE WATER IS SAFE TO DRINK. WE ARE UNABLE TO PROVIDE AN EXACT TIME OF SURVEY COMPLETION; HOWEVER, WE ESTIMATE THE TIME TO BE NO MORE THAN 72 HOURS. A RESCISSION NOTICE WILL BE DISTRIBUTED.
