



## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED SPECIAL ASSESSMENT**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Board of County Commissioners of Indian River County, Florida, will conduct a Public Hearing to consider approving a special assessment project in connection with a water main extension from 65<sup>th</sup> Street to 69<sup>th</sup> Street, along 51<sup>st</sup> Avenue to include certain specially benefited properties abutting 51<sup>st</sup> Avenue within a portion of Winter Beach Highlands and a portion of Winter Beach Park, located within unincorporated Indian River County, Florida.

The Public Hearing will be held on Tuesday, March 9, 2021 at 9:05 a.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, in the County Commission Chambers located on the first floor of Building A of the County Administrative Complex, 1801 27th Street, Vero Beach, Florida 32960, at which time interested parties may be heard with respect to the proposed project.

Any proposed documents, including the description of each property to be assessed and the amount to be assessed to each property, may be ascertained by the public during regular business hours (8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday) at either the Office of the Clerk to the Board of County Commissioners, located on the second floor of Building A of the County Administrative Complex, 1801 27th Street, Vero Beach, Florida or the Department of Utility Services, located on the first floor of Building A of the County Administrative Complex.

Anyone who may wish to appeal any decision which may be made at this meeting will need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which includes testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is based.
