NOTICE OF LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS TEXT AMENDMENT PUBLIC
HEARING

The Board of County Commissioners of Indian River County, Florida, will consider the adoption of a county ordinance amending the text of the land development regulations. A public hearing, at which parties in interest and citizens shall have an opportunity to be heard, will be held on Tuesday, July 5, 2022, at 9:00 a.m. in the County Commission Chambers of County Administration Building A, located at 1801 27th Street, Vero Beach, Florida. The proposed amendment is included in a proposed ordinance entitled:

AN ORDINANCE OF INDIAN RIVER COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING TITLE IX - LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS, CHAPTER 971 - REGULATIONS FOR SPECIFIC LAND USES, SECTION 971.41 – RESIDENTIAL USES, SUBSECTION 10 – ACCESSORY SINGLE-FAMILY DWELLING UNIT OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; AND PROVIDING CODIFICATION, SEVERABILITY, AND EFFECTIVE DATE
