**DISASTER SUPPLY KIT**  
(Recommended)

The following is a list of supplies you might need should you be required to evacuate your home in a disaster. Use quantities sufficient for 7-10 days. Store supplies in an easy-to-carry container such as a duffle/beach bag. Keep this list and any personal reminders with your supplies for easy reference.

**INCLUDE:**

- Water (1 gallon/person/day)
- Non-perishable food items
- Manually operated can opener
- Battery-operated radio/T.V.
- Flashlight(s)
- Ample supply of fresh batteries
- Personal hygiene items/sanitizing hand wipes
- First Aid Kit
- Two (2) week supply of medications
- Blankets/sleeping bag
- Extra clothing
- Lightweight folding chair/cot
- Personal items including books and quiet games/toys
- Infant necessities
- Important papers (driver's license, marriage license, birth certificate, deed to property, will, etc.)

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## Suggestions for portable sleeping items:

- 1) Coleman Converta Suspension Cot (Target approx. \$60.00)  
One position at night and another to lounge during the day. Folds up compactly.



- 2) Coleman Comfortsmart Folding Camping Cot (Walmart approx. \$40.00)  
Thick foam mattress and spring coil suspension.



- 3) Chaise Lounge Cushion (Walmart approx. \$38.86)



- 4) Inflatable airbed mattress (Walmart approx. \$25.00)  
Will need air pump.



- Consider using a yoga mat for cushion, if needed.
- Suggested items could be available at various stores including sporting goods stores, drug stores, Home Depot, Lowes, Target, Walmart, etc.
