**HOW  
DOES  
IT  
WORK?**

**T**his brochure shows how a pedestrian signal can help you safely cross busy streets in Indian River County.

The Indian River County Traffic Engineering Division recommends that all pedestrians use the pedestrian signals to cross a roadway.

Following the **four steps** illustrated in this brochure will help you cross a street safely. And remember, always check for on-coming traffic before you step into the crosswalk!

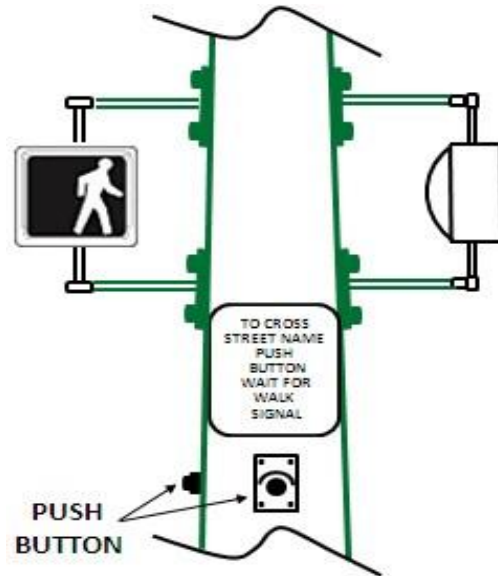
**Are you ready? Let's go!**

### **STEP 1: (PUSH BUTTON)**

Push the button, for the street you wish to cross, in order for the WHITE WALKING PERSON light (symbolizing WALK) to appear.

### **STEP 2: (WALK SYMBOL)**

When you see the WHITE WALKING PERSON light displayed:



- WATCH** for turning vehicles and oncoming traffic.
- When clear, then start **TO CROSS THE STREET**, the white walking person display may appear for only a few seconds.
- STAY** within the crosswalk, as you continue to cross.
- Right & Left-turning Vehicles should always **YIELD** to pedestrians crossing the road – **HOWEVER, BE A CAUTIOUS WALKER.**

### **STEP 3: (FLASHING DISPLAY)**

When you see the RED UPRAISED HAND (symbolizing DON'T WALK) flashing:



**FLASHING RED UPRAISED HAND**

- Continue Crossing** the street if you have started walking. The “flashing red UPRAISED HAND” display will give sufficient time to cross the street if you have already begun to cross.
- However, if you have not started crossing, push the button and **WAIT** for the next walk display.

### **STEP 4: (STEADY DISPLAY)**

When you see the STEADY RED “UPRAISED HAND” displayed:



There **should not** be any pedestrians in the crosswalk; you should have **finished crossing** the street.

- DON'T STEP INTO THE STREET.**
- Vehicular Traffic** is ready to start moving or is already moving.
